The International Workshop "Medical and biological aspects of supramolecular chemistry" will be held in House of Scientists of National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine in village Katsiveli on September 21 - 24, 2009. This workshop will be organized in the framework of the SupraChem and ARCUS "Alsace - Russia/Ukraine" projects.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The scientific program will be focused on molecular recognition in chemistry, biology and in drug design areas. The main objective of the Workshop is to bring together scientists from Russia, Ukraine and France, to discuss current collaborative projects as well as to establish new collaborations. The Workshop program will include Invited Lectures (30 min) and Round Tables. English is an official Workshop language; no translation will be provided.

The main topics of the workshop are:

- Supramolecular architectures in biology.
- Modelling of supramolecular systems in medicinal chemistry.
- Molecular mode of actions of endogenic and exogenic biological active substances.
