The following topics are selected for the scientific sessions:

- Molecular recognition and host-guest chemistry
- Self-assembly and guided supramolecular synthesis
- Supramolecular chemistry and nanofabrication
- Supramolecular science in drug design
- Supramolecular biomimetics
- Supramolecular interactions in biochemistry and molecular biology

The program will consist of invited lectures, oral presentations of young scientists and poster presentations.

All contributors are invited to submit a one page abstract in English.

An abstract should be submitted to the Organizers by e-mail as an attachment (RTF or DOC format). The abstract should be typed (1 page, Times New Roman 12 pts, 1.5 spaces between lines, all fields by 3 cm, 3 cm).Title: centered Times New Roman 14 pts, Bold. Authors (bold) and address: Times New Roman 12 centered
